Carbon Forest Project

The Carbon Forest Project mounted a display at Friends General Conference at Haverford College from June 30-July 5. Approximately 800 individuals were registered at the conference. John Munro and Nancy Donnelly discussed Unami Meeting's Carbon Forest Project at an afternoon presentation in addition to running this display showing carbon sequestration in several kinds of trees, coal and fossils, and offered brochures and a primer about the project. The CFP is seeking land, donations, and help and attended the Conference with those interests. Haverford College maintains a beautiful arboretum, and CFP has discussed possible seed sharing with them once CFP has land.
